MESSAGE SERIES: Attitude Adjustment // It has been said that the greatest Christian virtue is humility. As important as humility is, it is often misunderstood. Humility is not thinking less of yourself, it is thinking of yourself less. Humility is not practiced because we are unaware of the benefits - specifically that he who humbles himself will be exalted. LifeTeen is our youth ministry experience open to all high school students. Teens worship, learn and grow as they get to know the Lord Jesus. Life Teen students go deeper with one another and adult mentors, and form life-long friendships. LifeTeen meets every Saturday evening following our 5PM Mass. We have a quick bite to eat, and then launch into our program for the evening.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS // We pray the Stations of the Cross every Friday in Lent starting at 7PM. The Stations are a traditional devotion tracing the events on the way to Christ's crucifixion. Come and pray the Stations of the Cross with us. Bring your family.
